


CELEBRATING GROWTH & SUPPORTING 1000 FAMILIES

By 2008, we were up to helping 100 families and had to move our wrapping operations out of our homes and into a church basement at Young and Eglington. We crossed the threshold of helping 500 families in 2016, and moved into a permanent office at Renforth and Eglinton and hired our first team members.

The growth of Holiday Helpers has been slow and steady over the last two decades. So, hitting the goal of sponsoring 1,000 families in one year was cause for a small celebration with the team and volunteers! Reaching this milestone is not the effort of one or two people. It takes thousands of people working together with an common mission to give back to their community.
